WHOLESALE TRADE
April 1968

Sales of Canadian wholeselers for the month of April 1968 are estimated at $\$ 1,203,920,000$, an increase of $5.0 \%$ over the same month in 1967. These sales are those of wholesalers proper and do not include the business transactions of manufacturers' sales branches or agents and brokers. They are not adjusted for price changes, seasonsl variations or number of business days in the respective months.

April sales wore greater in oleven of the eighteen specified trades. Inereases ranged from 1.66 in Hardware to $24.4 \%$ in Fresh Fruits and Vegetablos. Decreases in six trades ranged from 0.18 in Tobacco, Confectionery and Soft Drinks to 20.5\% in Farm Machinery. The remaining specified trade, Other Textile and Clothing Accessories, was virtually unchanged from last year. Sales in the "All other trades" group increased by $12.4 \%$.

For the first four months of 1968, sales are estimated at $\$ 4,473,523,000$, an increase of 4. 38 over the same period in 1967. Twelve of the specified trades showed increases, ranging from $1.8 \%$ in Industrial and Transportation Equipment and Supplies to $16.7 \%$ in Frosh Fruits and Vegetables. Decroases in six trados ranged from 0.8 in Clothing and Furnishings to $14.4 \%$ in Farm Machinery. Sales of the "All other trades" group increased by 1.31.
