


To prevent disclosure of statistics of individual establishments, the provinces of Prince Edward Island and Nova Scotia have been combined throughout the tables of this report.

Comparative Statistics

A table showing comparative statistics covering the period from the inception of the annual census to date is appended. The figures for the years 1921-1924 included a large number of hand laundries which have been eliminated in succeeding years, the inclusion of which appears to have but little effect in swelling the totals of the various statistical items except in the number of establishments. The value of production since 1918 shows a gradual increase till 1920, the year of high prices, is reached. In 1921 owing to world-wide depression in industry the gross value of production had fallen to \$13,878,805 but from this date forward, with a return to normal conditions, increases have been maintained, the high point being reached in 1929.



Size of Establishments

The tendency towards concentration in industrial enterprises is exemplified in a series of tables showing in a threefold way the size of establishments in the Laundry and Dyeing Industry measured by (a) capital investment, (b) gross value of production and (c) the number of persons employed, all within certain groups or limitations, for the calendar years 1928 and 1929. The tables also serve to indicate the movement of capital, production and employment within the industry.

In 1928, the total number of establishments reporting had risen to 375, the total capital investment to \$23,592,606, the gross value of production to \$23,618,823 and the total employment to 11,669. Of the total number of establishments 26 had a total invested capital of \$11,292,139 or nearly 48 per cent of the total and an average investment per plant of \$434,313. Twenty-three establishments had a combined output of \$8,590,124 or more than 36 per cent of the total and an average output of \$373,484 per establishment. In employment, 25 establishments had a combined payroll of 4,098 individuals or 35 per cent of the total with an average employment of 164 per establishment.

In 1929, the total number of establishments reporting fell to 374 but the total capital investment rose to \$26,839,632, the gross value of production to \$26,559,285, and the total employment to 12,706. Of the total number of establishments 26 had a total invested capital of \$12,921,506 or 48 per cent of the total and an average

investment per plant of \$496,981. Twenty-six establishments had a combined output of \$10,424,833 or more than 39 per cent of the total and an average output of \$400,955 per establishment. In employment 26 establishments had a combined payroll of 4,538 individuals or 35 per cent of the total with an average employment of 175 per establishment.



Production Statistics

The statistics of production in the Laundry and Dyeing Industry for the calendar years 1928 and 1929 are shown by values only in Table 1. The increase in production over 1928 was \$2,940,462 and the provinces contributing thereto were in order, Ontario \$1,065,119, Quebec \$955,111, British Columbia \$287,445, Manitoba \$204,882, Alberta \$129,284, Prince Edward Island and Nova Scotia \$103,571, Saskatchewan \$74,973, and New Brunswick \$50,077. The statistics for Prince Edward Island have been combined with those of Nova Scotia to prevent disclosure of individual information.

The statistics published in the present statement are not to be considered as comprehensive because such operations as dyeing, bleaching, etc., are also carried on in various textile industries as a principal process in the preparation of their finished products to adapt them for further manufacture and sale.





Table 2 presents statistics of capital invested for the Dominion and the provinces for the calendar years 1928 and 1929 under two main heads,- fixed capital and working capital. The former includes the value of land, buildings and machinery and tools, whilst the latter includes (a) material and stocks on hand, finished products, stocks in process, fuel, etc., (b) Cash, trading and operating accounts, etc. The increase in capital investment in 1929 amounted to \$3,247,026 or 13.76 per cent. Each of the provinces showed an increase in capital investment, Quebec being highest with \$1,262,641 or approximately 39 per cent of the total increase in the industry.



The number of persons employed according to sex together with the amounts paid for salaries, wages, etc., is shown in Table 3 for the calendar years 1928 and 1929. The increase in employment in 1929 numbered 1,037 of whom 368 were males and 669 were females. Salaries increased by \$265,631, and wages by \$1,056,594.

Employment Statistics - Con.

Table 4 shows the number at employment in the Dominion classified by sex for each month of the calendar years 1928 and 1929. The maximum of employment was reached in the month of September during both years and the minimum in the month of January. The average monthly employment which is based on the actual operating time of each individual plant, rose from 10,653 employees in 1928 to 11,629 in 1929 or approximately 9.2 per cent.



Tables 6(a) and 6(b) present statistics of wage-earning employees, in month of highest employment working specified hours, for Canada and the provinces during 1928 and 1929. Table 6(a) shows the number of persons employed at each daily rate and also the percentages of wage-earners at such daily rate. It will be seen that over 31 per cent of the employees worked 8 hours per day or less in 1929. Those working 9 hours per day were over 44 per cent, whilst those working 10 hours per day and over were 25 per cent.



Table 6(b) shows the hours of labour per day and per week for the calendar years 1928 and 1929. The statistics relating to hours of labour in column 1, 2 and 3 are compiled from the number of employees working specified daily hours in the month of highest employment whilst those in columns 4 and 5 represent the standard weekly hours of labour in the industry as reported to the Bureau by individual establishments.

The average daily hours of labour computed on the above basis for the Dominion was 8.90 in 1928 and 8.97 in 1929, while the average standard working hours per week were 49.26 in 1928 and 49.31 in 1929. Average daily hours of labour were highest in Quebec during both years and lowest in British Columbia.

Fuel Consumption

The laundry and dyeing industry as a consumer of fuel occupied the fifteenth place in Canadian industries in 1929. Table 7 shows the consumption of the various classes of fuel by quantity and cost value at the works. The value of coal and coke which in 1928 totalled \$804,385 for the Dominion rose to \$874,789 in 1929. Gasoline decreased during this period from \$38,447 to \$7,756 whilst fuel oils show an increase of \$681. The increase in the cost of fuel over 1928 was \$42,664 or 4.3 per cent.



Power Installation

The classes of power installed in the industry are shown in Table 8 by provinces according to (a) the number of units in each class and (b) the horsepower according to manufacturer's rating. The total primary power installation was 5,854 in 1928 and 5,826 in 1929. Electric power purchased rose from 8,645 H.P. in 1928 to 9,273 H.P. in 1929, representing an increase of over 7 per cent. Boiler installation for all purposes rose from 367 units with a rated boiler H.P. capacity of 27,442 in 1928 to 400 units with a capacity of 30,933 H.P. in 1929. The cost of electricity purchased was \$205,103 in 1928 and \$238,543 in 1929, an increase over 1928 of approximately 16 per cent.



The cost of materials used in each section of the industry with totals for the combined industries is shown in Table 9 for the calendar years 1928 and 1929. The cost of materials in 1929 amounted to \$3,403,667, whilst in 1928 the cost was \$3,007,047.






