## MOTION PICTURE PRODUCTION

## 1 9 5 8

This report covers the 1958 operations of 53 private firms and 7 government agencies primarily engaged in the production and printing of motion picture films and film strips for industry, government, education, entertainment, etc. Five other firms coming to our attention which did not meet the classification requirement produced 1 feature film, 1 theatrical short and 4 non-theatrical films of 5 minutes or longer; 1 newsreel or ciné-magazine and 56 newsclips were produced for television and 3 commercial advertising films were produced for other uses. These firms derived \$48,471 of their total revenue of \$272,746 from the production of motion pictures. Figures relating to the above-mentioned 5 firms are not included in any of the tables contained in this report.

The statistics shown in the following table pertain only to the private industry sector. The employment figures do not include proprietors of unincorporated firms.

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## Summary Statistics

Table 1 of this report gives detail by region of entertainment, documentary and instructional films of 5 minutes or longer and less than 5 minutes and of publicity, news and other films for the years 1957 and 1958. This breakdown differs somewhat from that followed in the 1957 report and care should be taken in making comparisons. Table 2 contains a technical and language classification of films of 5 minutes or longer. Of the total of 689 films of 5 minutes or longer reported by private industry, 1 theatrical, 239 television and 39 other non-theatrical films were adaptations or language versions of the original films. Eight were made for other than Canadian sponsors. Twelve theatrical, 14 television and 118 other non-theatrical films of 5 minutes or longer were reported by government agencies as adaptations or language versions of the original films. Ten of the films produced were made for other than Canadian sponsors.

Private industry and government agencies printed 47,670,511 feet of 16MM film and 24,427,610 feet of 35MM in black and white. The division of colour film was 5,598,226 feet of 16MM and 19,809 feet of 35MM.

## Notes:

- 1. In 1957 firms were not asked to distinguish shorts of less than 5 minutes duration and it is possible that the 60 theatrical shorts shown include films which belong to the new group of less than 5 minutes.
- 2. Similarly, in 1957, firms were not asked to report separately non-commercial advertising films and it is possible that the 1,844 commercial advertising films shown include a few films (not more than 50) which should be added to the figure 737 shown in brackets.
