MOTION PICTURE PRODUCTION

1965

This report covers the 1965 operations of 74 private firms and 8 government agencies principally engaged in the production and printing of motion picture films and film strips for industry, government, education, entertainment, etc. It does not cover production by television stations. Five other firms coming to our attention which did not meet the classification requirements produced 5 information or documentary films for television use, 11 non-theatrical films, 112 commercial advertising films for television, 24 other films for unspecified use and 21 sound film strips. These firms derived \$152,956 of their total revenue of \$401,525 from the production of motion pictures. Figures relating to these 5 firms are not included in any of the tables shown in this report. The report covers 4 firms primarily engaged in video tape production and statistics on these are shown in a separate section (Table 3). The statistics shown in the following table pertain only to the private sector (do not include government agencies or religious institutions). The employment figures do not include proprietors of unincorporated firms.

SUMMARY STATISTICS

Table 1 of this report gives detail by region of entertainment, documentary, instructional, publicity, news and other films. Table 2 contains a technical and language classification of entertainment, documentary and instructional films.

Private industry and government agencies printed 67,875,718 feet of 16 mm film and 18,339,368 feet of 35 mm in black and white; 16,190,992 feet of 16 mm film and 3,094,977 feet of 35 mm film were in colour.

There were 15 sound motion pictures of 5 minutes or longer made for other than Canadian sponsors.
