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# SALES AND FINANCING OF MOTOR VEHICLES CANADA, 1947 

Introduction

This report brings together in summary form information on the distribution of motor vehicles at the retail level. Two phases of activity are reviewed--sales and financing. Results for 1947 are given in some detail, but many tables and charts have been included to illustrate trends over the past several years.

Sources and Scope of Statistics
Statistics on new motor vehicle sales are compiled monthly from reports provided by Canadian head offices of companies manufacturing or assembling in Canada, and from external head offices or Canadian distributing centres in the case of imported vehicles. The series was instituted in 1932, but collection of information was suspended during 1944 and 1945. Records of releases from the Government's reserve bank have been used for these two years to bridge the gap between the former and the present series. In 1946, the Bureau reinstituted monthly statistics on new motor vehicle sales using the same sources as in the earlier period.

Retall deliveries are reported separately for both passenger and commercial vehicles, by provinces. Motor vehicles sold to the Government for war purposes are not included in the published results.

Canadian finance companies report to the Bureau the number and financed value of new and used motor vehicles financed, by provinces, each month. This series has been maintained continuously since 1929. Prior to 1946, no distinction was made between passenger and commercial models, but these are now reported separately and are surmarized for 1947 in this publication. Re-financing is not reported.

Reports are issued monthly on each of the two phases of the motor vehicle field. The subscription rate is $\$ 1.00$ per year in each case.

> New Motor Vehicle Sales

With littie or no decline in demand and with sales depending almost wholly on availability of vehicles, previous records of new motor vehicle sales were exceeded by a wide margin in 1947. New vehicle sales reached a total of 230,255 units with a retail value of $\$ 416,237,495$. Statistics were not compiled prior to 1932, but it is believed that the 1947 totals surpassed those for the most flourishing of pre-depression years. Unit sales almost doubled in 1947, while the dollar values recorded a gain of more than $100 \%$ over 1946 when 120,044 vehicles were sold for $\$ 193,329,005$.

Passenger car sales totalled 159 , 205 units at a retail value of $\$ 83,190,390$ in 1947. In 1946, a total of 77.742 new passenger vehicles retailed for $\$ 120,325,496$. The proportion of commercial vehicle sales to the total remained quite high, in terms of prewar characteristics, accounting for $31 \%$ of all new vehicles sold last year. Trucks and buses sold in 1947 numbered 71,050 and were valued at $\$ 133, \overline{04,105}$.

Sales of motor vehicles were at a very high level even at the beginning of 1947 mat a much higher point than was reached in any month of 1946. While remaining at an elevated level throughout the year, the trend followed much the same pattern as that ostablished in 1946. The movement was steadily upward until july. After a brief interruption in August, there was a sharp rise in September to a now allotime peak, and a further slight uptirn in October. From that point sales slipped downe ward in the last two months of the year, though continuing on a relatively high plane.

There has been no pronounced shift in the percentage distribution of new motor vehicle sales regionally during the past decsde. Ontario absorbed $46.0 \%$ of 1947 consumption, a percentage which is somewhat below pre-war averages and slightly lower than that of $47.7 \%$ in 1946. The positions of Alberta and British Columbia were more important in 1947 absorbing the Ontario decrease.

Provincial distribution of commercial vehicle sales has customarily been less concentrated in Ontario and Quebec. Ontario accounted for $35 \%$ of the total in 1947, but in all other provinces except Quebec and British Columbia, the proportions are somewhat greater for comercial than for passenger vehicles.

## Purchase Prices

The average purchase price of new motor vehicles again moved sharply upward in 1947. The greater increase last year occurred in passenger car prices which moved from an average of $\$ 1,548$ in 1946 to $\$ 1,797$ in 1947. Average selling prices of commercial vehicles rose from $\$ 1,726$ in 1946 to $\$ 1.873$ in 1947. The range in average passenger car prices was between $\$ 1,000$ and $\$ 1,100$ from 1932 to 1940. Prices rose sharply in 1941 to $\$ 1,300$. Successive rises in the next two years added a further $\$ 100$ to the average price. For the years 1944 and 1945 the Bureau has no records of average values, but by 1946 there had been a marked increase to $\$ 1,548$ before the sharp upturn in values took place in 1947 which raised the average to $\$ 1,779$ for that yoar.

## Sessonal Patterna

Demand for new motor vehicles showed no sign of diminishing in 1947. As in 1946, there was also little evidence of the customary pre-war sessonal pattern of sales, Sales in spring months, which had in formor years accounted for a high proportion of annual volume, were actually smaller in 1947 than the average monthly volume. The chart at the left shows the number of new passenger cars sold in each month of 1946 and 1947, together with the average number of units sold in the four-year pre-war period 1937-1940. The departure from the pre-war seasonal pattern of sales is clearly indicated.


## Motor Vohicle Financing

A sharp rise in the financing of motor vehicles accompanied the the expansion in their retail distribution. While this rise was proportionately as great in financing as in sales between 1946 and 1947, the level of financing remains well below peak volumes of the late 1930's and early years of the present decade. This condition indicates that a relatively high proportion of new vehicle purchases are being made for cash, or through loan arrangements not handled by finance companies themselves.

Last year, 46,700 new vehicles were financed for an amount of $\$ 65,422,230$. These figures included 27,409 passenger models which were financed to the extent of $\$ 32,418,868$ and 19,291 trucks and buses financed for $\$ 33,003,362$. Average financed value for all new vehicles financed was $\$ 1,401$, while for new passenger cars the average was $\$ 1,183$ and for new commercial vehicles, $\$ 1,711$. The average financed value of new vehicles was at its lowest in 1930 when the figure was $\$ 597$. By the middle of the last decade the average was in the vicinity of $\$ 700$, approached $\$ 800$ at the beginning of the war and mounted fairly steadily thereafter.

Used vehicle financing increased sharply in 1947, the increasing output of new vehicles permitting a greater amount of trading in secondhand cars. The total of 72,167 units financed for $\$ 43,322,528$ was made up of 56,024 passenger cars and 16,143 trucks and buses. Although the number of units financed has been surpassed in a number of earlier years, the amount of financing was exceeded only in 1941. The average financed value of used vehicles has also reached a high point, the $\$ 600$ average for 1947 being well above that for any other year in the series. The average was as low as $\$ 259$ in 1934.

## Sales and Financing of New Vehicles Compared

Of the total of new vehicles sold in 1947, only $20 \%$ were financed through finance companies. The percentage remained almost the same as in 1946, much below the ratio prevailing in the 1930's when the range was frora $32 \%$ to $39 \%$.

The proportion of sales financed in 1947 was somewhat higher for commercial vehicles ( $27 \%$ ) than for passenger models ( $17 \%$ ).
