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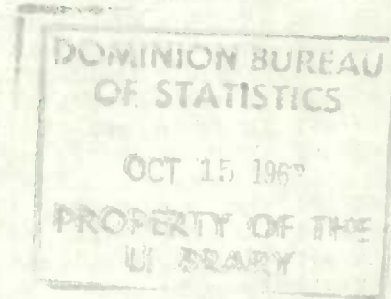

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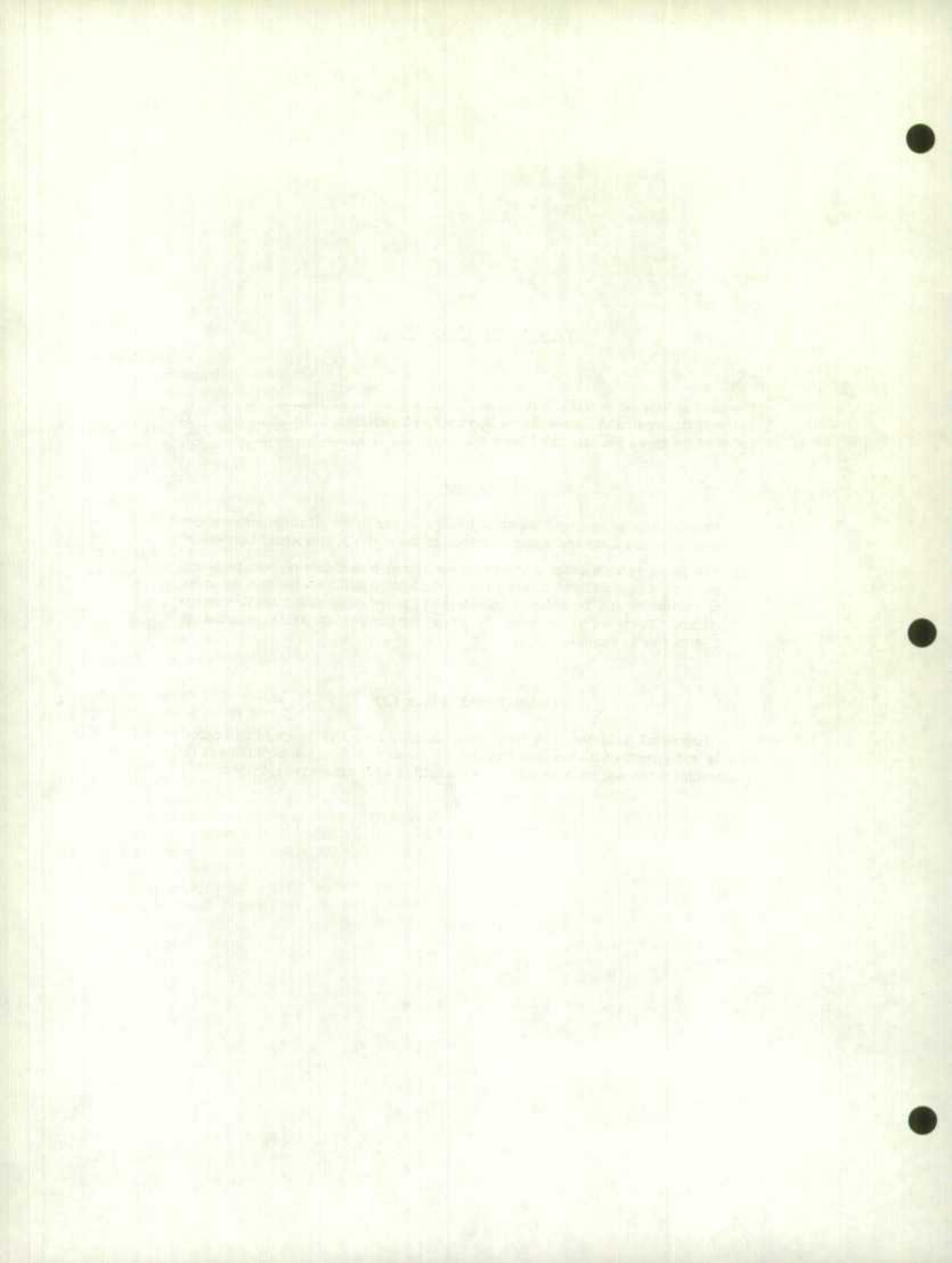
NOTES

This bulletin summarizes the statistics published in the monthly series under the same title and contains minor revisions to the monthly data where necessary.

1. **New Motor Vehicle Sales** statistics are obtained from Canadian manufacturers who report consolidated totals of their dealers' monthly statements on sales to customers and from direct importers of cars of other than Canadian manufacture. Every effort is made to avoid duplication of sales reported by distributors of European cars.

COMMERCIAL VEHICLES

Commercial Vehicles is a term which is used for convenience in this report and is synonymous with the term "trucks and buses". Passenger models used for commercial purposes, such as taxis, are classified with passenger vehicles.



NEW MOTOR VEHICLE SALES 1962

The total number of new motor vehicles sold in Canada during 1962, surpassed the previous high registered in 1960. There were 585,210 new vehicles at a retail value of \$1,782,916,000 sold in 1962, an increase over the previous year of 14.4 per cent in number of units sold and 14.9 per cent in dollar volume.

Both passenger cars and commercial vehicles sold in increasing numbers as compared to the previous year. Sales of passenger cars increased by 14.9 per cent and commercial vehicles by 11.4 per cent.

The increase in motor vehicle sales during 1962 was due entirely to the sales of Canadian/United States manufactured vehicles. As can be seen from the tables, the sales of motor vehicles of overseas origin registered a substantial decline for the second year in a row. In 1961 the sales of passenger cars and commercial vehicles of overseas origin declined by 19.7 per cent and 15.3 per cent respectively; in 1962, the decline was 25.5 per cent and 33.9 per cent respectively. These declines for two consecutive years have caused the overseas new motor vehicle share of the market to contract to 13.6 per cent of the total number of new vehicles sold as compared to a high of 25.4 per cent registered in 1960.

Sales of Canadian/United States new passenger cars increased by 27.1 per cent in 1962. All provinces in Canada showed increased sales of pas-

senger cars with British Columbia and Quebec registering the most substantial increases—54.3 per cent and 34.5 per cent respectively. On the other hand, sales of passenger cars of overseas origin declined in every province; Ontario and Manitoba registering the most severe decline—29.4 per cent and 27.5 per cent respectively.

Ontario's share of the new motor vehicle market continued to decline from 40.0 per cent in 1961 to 39.2 per cent in 1962. On the other hand, Quebec's share of the new motor vehicle market has shown another increase in 1962, reaching 26.0 per cent as compared to 25.5 per cent in 1961,

For those readers who may have missed the 1961 annual motor vehicle report, the following paragraph contained in that report is now reprinted.

The readers of this report will notice that the format has undergone a number of changes which have been designed to improve the usefulness of this report. For example, data on overseas manufactured vehicles are shown separately by provinces and by months in regard to both number of vehicles sold and the total retail value. The reader will also notice that information on motor vehicle financing is no longer contained in this report. The decision to discontinue the publication of motor vehicle financing in this report was given in the 1960 annual motor vehicle report. This data, however will be available in our 1962 report Sales Financing, catalogue No. 63-211.

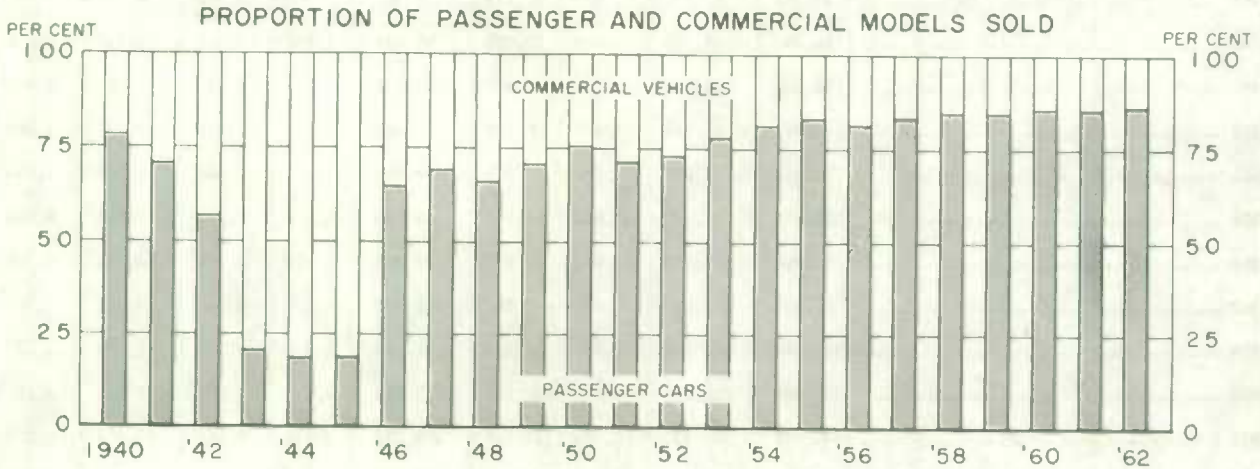
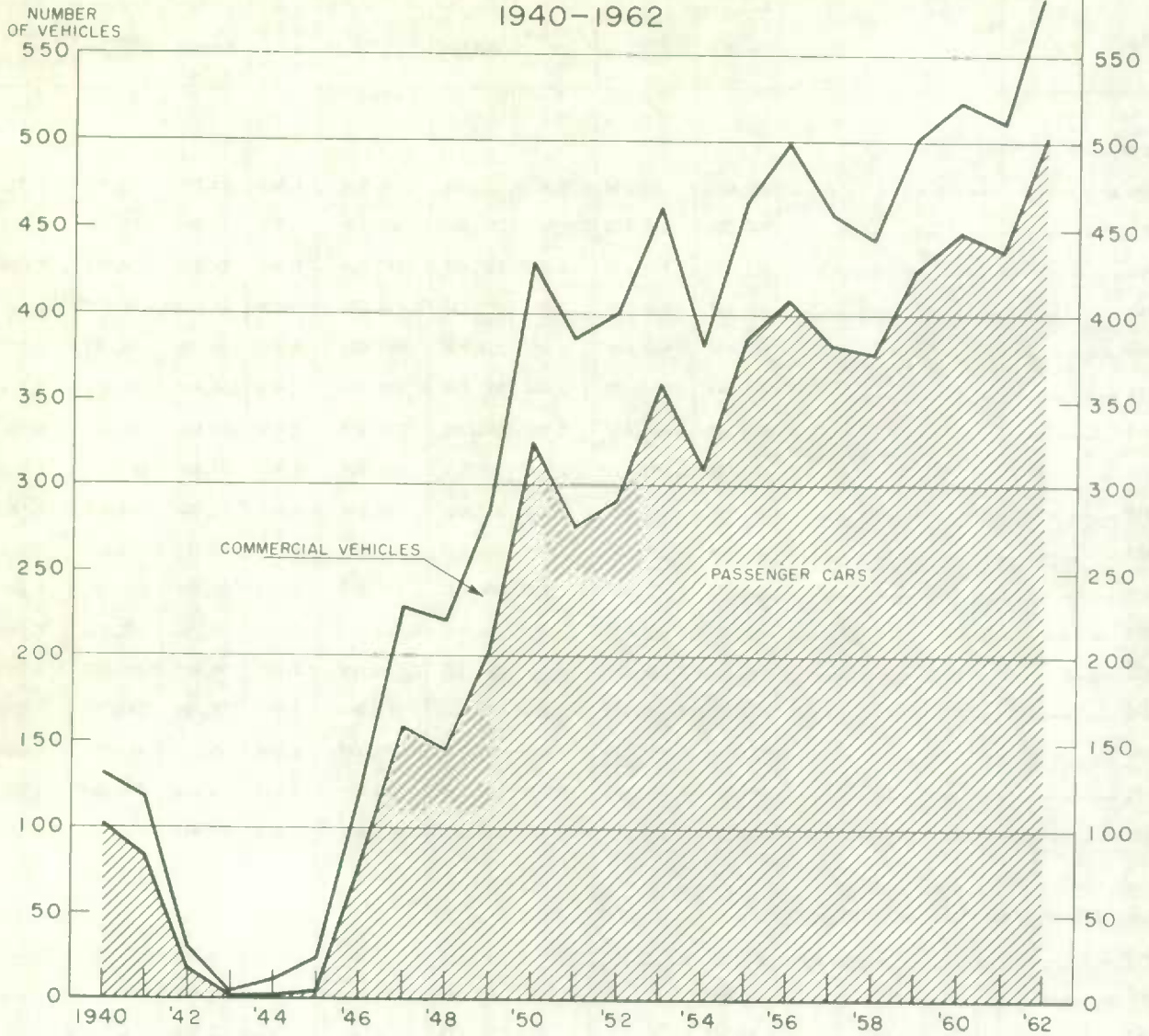
