- A. **Sources of Statistics:** Canada's external trade statistics are tabulated from copies of administrative documents collected by Revenue Canada, Customs at its ports across Canada. The Customs Act requires that each time goods are imported into or exported from Canada a document be filed with Customs giving such descriptions of the goods and details of the transaction as are required for the purposes of Customs administration. It follows that the method of compilation of external trade statistics is determined and limited to some extent by Customs regulations and procedures. Where these affect the precise or consistent application of the statistical principles explained in the following section, their impact is described in qualitative terms only.

Statistics on trade in electricity and on exports of crude petroleum and natural gas cannot, for administrative reasons, be obtained from Customs documents. They are instead collected by the Manufacturing and Primary Industries Division of Statistics Canada, with important statistical consequences explained in Note 4 below.

Import statistics for shipments from the United States of less than \$2,500 are estimated on the basis of a 10 per cent sample of such shipments. The size of this sample is at present in excess of 20,000 shipments per month.

Export statistics for shipments of less than \$2,500 from Quebec, Ontario, Manitoba and British Columbia to the United States are estimated on the basis of a 20 per cent sample. The size of this sample is at present in excess of 10,000 shipments per month.

- B. **Concepts and Definitions Used in the Compilation of External Trade Statistics:** The most comprehensive set of principles for the compilation of trade statistics is to be found in *International Trade Statistics: Concepts and Definitions*, published by the United Nations Statistical Office (Series M, No. 52; New York, 1970). The following notes are both a summary of these principles and a description of the choices and exceptions made in the case of Canada's external trade statistics.

1. **System of Trade:** Canadian statistics are tabulated according to the "general" system of trade. Thus *imports* include all goods which have crossed Canada's geographical boundary, whether they are entered through Customs for immediate consumption in Canada or stored in bonded Customs warehouses. *Domestic exports* include goods grown, extracted or manufactured in Canada (including goods of foreign origin which have been materially transformed in Canada). *Re-exports* are exports of goods of foreign origin which have not been materially transformed in Canada (including goods withdrawn for export from bonded Customs warehouses).

The trade statistics do not include exports to Canadian diplomatic or military posts abroad nor imports by foreign diplomatic or military posts in Canada because such posts are considered to be within the geographical boundary of the sponsor country. Purchases or sales of bunker supplies and stores for ships or aircraft engaged in international traffic, tourist purchases and settlers' effects are excluded for practical reasons. Goods which cross the Canadian border for convenience of transportation only are not included in trade statistics.

2. **Coverage:** Merchandise trade includes only goods which add to or subtract from the stock of material resources in Canada as a result of their movement across the Canadian border. Consequently, goods intended to be returned to the exporting country after a short period of time are excluded from trade statistics (when this intention is apparent from the Customs documentation). Examples of such transactions are works of art loaned for exhibition, vehicles or horses exported to compete in races, and films exported for processing and return. Goods exported or imported for purposes of repair only are excluded from statistics, although payments or receipts for repairs are included in the trade statistics. Financial assets such as circulating coin, stocks and bonds are also excluded from the trade statistics.

- A. **Sources des statistiques:** Les statistiques sur le commerce extérieur du Canada sont totalisées à partir des copies des documents administratifs recueillis par Revenu Canada (Douanes) dans ses bureaux de douane par tout le Canada. La Loi sur les douanes exige que chaque fois que des marchandises sont importées au Canada ou exportées du pays, une déclaration soit faite précisant la nature des marchandises et donnant le détail de l'opération commerciale d'après les besoins de la réglementation de l'administration douanière. Il s'ensuit que la méthode de production de statistiques sur le commerce extérieur est déterminée et limitée dans une certaine mesure par les règlements et les procédures des douanes. Lorsque ceux-ci nuisent à l'application précise ou uniforme des principes statistiques exposés dans la section suivante, leur incidence est décrite en termes qualitatifs seulement.

Des statistiques sur le commerce de l'énergie électrique et sur les exportations de pétrole brut et de gaz naturel ne peuvent, pour des raisons administratives, être tirées des documents de douane. Elles sont plutôt recueillies par la Division des industries manufacturières et primaires de Statistique Canada; les conséquences importantes sur le plan statistique sont expliquées à la note 4 ci-dessous.

Les chiffres d'importation portant sur les livraisons en provenance des États-Unis avec une valeur inférieure à \$2,500 sont préparés d'après un échantillon de 10 pour cent. Cet échantillon comprend actuellement plus de 20,000 envois par mois.

Les chiffres d'exportation portant sur les livraisons avec une valeur inférieure à \$2,500 en provenance du Québec, de l'Ontario, du Manitoba et de la Colombie-Britannique vers les États-Unis sont préparés d'après un échantillon de 20 pour cent. Cet échantillon comprend actuellement plus de 10,000 envois par mois.

- B. **Concepts et définitions utilisés dans la production de statistiques sur le commerce extérieur:** L'ensemble le plus complet de principes directeurs pour la préparation de ces statistiques est présenté dans *Statistiques du commerce international: concepts et définitions*, publié par le Bureau de statistique des Nations Unies (série M, no 52, New York, 1970). Les notes suivantes résument ces principes et décrivent les choix et les exceptions dans le cas de la statistique du commerce extérieur du Canada.

1. **Système commercial:** Les statistiques canadiennes sont totalisées selon le système commercial "général". Ainsi, les *importations* comprennent tous les biens qui ont franchi les limites géographiques du Canada, qu'ils soient passés par les douanes pour être consommés immédiatement au Canada ou qu'ils aient été entreposés en douane. Les *exportations nationales* comprennent les biens cultivés, extraits ou fabriqués au Canada (y compris les biens d'origine étrangère qui ont été transformés au Canada). Les *réexportations* sont des exportations de biens d'origine étrangère qui n'ont pas été transformés matériellement au Canada (y compris les biens retirés des entrepôts de douane en vue de leur exportation).

La statistique du commerce ne prend pas en compte les exportations vers des missions diplomatiques ou militaires canadiennes à l'étranger ni les importations attribuables à des missions étrangères semblables au Canada, car on considère que ces missions ne se trouvent pas hors des limites géographiques du pays qui les a envoyées. Les achats ou les ventes d'approvisionnement de navires ou d'aéronefs affectés au transport international, les achats des touristes et les effets des migrants sont exclus pour des raisons pratiques. Les biens auxquels on fait franchir la frontière canadienne uniquement pour en faciliter le transport sont laissés hors compte.

2. **Champ d'observation:** Le commerce de marchandises ne comprend que les biens dont le passage d'un côté à l'autre de la frontière canadienne augmente ou diminue le stock de ressources matérielles du Canada. Ainsi, les biens qui seront renvoyés dans le pays exportateur après un court laps de temps sont exclus de la statistique du commerce (lorsque cette intention se dégage des documents de douane). Citons à titre d'exemple les oeuvres d'art prêtées pour une exposition, les véhicules ou les chevaux exportés en vue d'une course, les films exportés pour être développés, puis retournés. Les biens exportés ou importés pour fins de réparation seulement ne sont pas pris en compte, bien que les paiements ou les recettes au titre des réparations soient portés dans la statistique du commerce. Des avoirs financiers comme le numéraire non périmé, les actions et les obligations sont également laissés hors compte.

3. **Valuation:** *Exports* are recorded at the values declared on export documents, which usually reflect the actual selling price or, in the case of non-arms-length transactions, the transfer price used for company accounting purposes. Most exports are valued at the place in Canada where they are laden aboard a carrier for export (e.g. mine, farm or factory) but a significant proportion of exports by water or air reflect values which include transportation charges to the port of export. Some overland shipments to the United States are recorded at a value which includes part or all of the transportation charges to the ultimate destination because such transportation charges cannot be identified and removed.

*Imports* are generally recorded at the values established for Customs duty purposes according to the provisions of the Customs Act. Customs values are identical to selling prices for most arms-length transactions. However, Customs values exceed company transfer prices for most transactions between affiliated firms. (Beginning in 1970, imports of automotive products from the United States have been recorded at company transfer prices rather than Customs values.) Import documents are required to show values which exclude all transportation charges. Some imports from the United States are however purchased on a "delivered" basis and their prices therefore reflect an allowance for transportation costs.

4. **Timing:** Until July 1979, statistics for a month included all shipments for which Customs documents were received at Statistics Canada up to, and including, the last working day of the month. Starting with data for August 1979, the closing of the statistical month will be defined according to the last calendar day of the month, based, as closely as practicable, on the date of clearance from Customs. Individual shipments may not be recorded in statistics until some time after their arrival or departure because of administrative procedures which permit late filing of documents. Trade in electricity; exports of both crude petroleum and natural gas; and Imports of "Swap Oil" from the United States for a given month are included in statistics for the following month because they are collected too late for inclusion in statistics for the month indicated (see Sources of Statistics).
5. **Trading Partner Attribution:** *Imports* are attributed to the country from which the goods were first consigned directly to Canada, whether or not this is the country of origin. An exception is made in the case of goods of Central or South American origin consigned to Canada from the United States; such imports are credited to the country of origin, except for "Swap Oil" from the United States which are credited to this country.

*Exports* are attributed to the country which is the last known destination of the goods at the time of export. (Many primary products are shipped to entrepôt points, particularly in Europe, for re-export to the ultimate destination which is unknown when the goods leave Canada.) The country classification employed by the External Trade Division of Statistics Canada is designed for purposes of economic geography and therefore does not reflect the views or intentions of the Government of Canada on international issues of recognition, sovereignty or jurisdiction.

6. **Revisions of Statistics:** The statistics in this report for the current month are preliminary and subject to revision at any time until the January report for the following year has been published. Statistics for previous years are subject to revision in the April issue. Statistical series are adjusted for seasonal variation using Census Method II (X-11 variant); these adjustments are also revised in the April issue of each year.

3. **Evaluation:** Les *exportations* sont présentées selon les valeurs déclarées dans les documents d'exportation; il s'agit habituellement du prix de vente réel ou, dans le cas des opérations entre entreprises affiliées, du prix de transfert adopté par les sociétés à des fins comptables. La plupart des exportations sont évaluées au point du territoire du Canada (mine, ferme ou usine) où elles sont chargées et ainsi confiées à un transporteur en vue de leur exportation, mais une partie importante des exportations par eau ou par air se voit attribuer une valeur qui comprend les frais de transport vers le port d'exportation. Pour certaines livraisons par voie de terre vers les États-Unis, la valeur indiquée comprend en partie ou en totalité les frais de transport jusqu'à la destination ultime parce qu'on ne peut isoler et retrancher ces frais.

Les *importations* sont habituellement présentées selon les valeurs établies aux fins du prélèvement des droits de douane conformément aux dispositions de la Loi sur les douanes. Les valeurs des douanes sont identiques aux prix de vente dans le cas de la plupart des opérations entre parties indépendantes. Toutefois, les valeurs douanières dépassent les prix de transfert des sociétés dans le cas de la majorité des opérations entre entreprises affiliées. (À partir de 1970, les importations de produits de l'industrie automobile en provenance des États-Unis sont indiquées aux prix de transfert et non pas selon les valeurs fixées en douane.) Les valeurs déclarées dans les documents d'importation ne doivent pas comprendre les frais de transport. Certaines importations en provenance des États-Unis sont toutefois sur une base de livraison et leur prix englobe par conséquent les frais de transport.

4. **Période:** Jusqu'à juillet 1979, les statistiques d'un mois donnaient toutes les livraisons pour lesquelles Statistique Canada a reçu des documents de douane jusqu'au dernier jour ouvrable du mois. À partir du mois d'août 1979, la fin du mois statistique correspondra au dernier jour du mois civil où s'effectue, dans la mesure du possible, le dédouanement. De diverses livraisons peuvent ne pas être prises en compte dès leur arrivée ou leur départ à cause de la procédure administrative qui donne lieu à une présentation tardive des documents. Le commerce d'énergie électrique; les exportations de pétrole brut de gaz naturel; les importations selon l'arrangement avec les États-Unis pour des échanges de pétrole brut d'un mois donné sont présentés dans les statistiques du mois suivant parce qu'on obtient les données trop tard pour qu'elles puissent faire partie des statistiques du mois de référence (voir Sources des Statistiques).
5. **Partenaires commerciaux et attribution:** Les *importations* sont attribuées au pays de première consignation directe des biens au Canada, que ce soit ou non le pays d'origine. On déroge à cette règle dans le cas des biens ayant comme région d'origine l'Amérique centrale ou l'Amérique du Sud et expédiés au Canada depuis les États-Unis; ces importations sont portées au crédit du pays d'origine, sauf pour les échanges de pétrole brut avec les États-Unis qui sont crédités à ce pays.

Les *exportations* sont attribuées au pays de dernière destination connu au moment de l'exportation. (De nombreux produits "primaires" sont expédiés vers des points d'entreposage, notamment en Europe, en vue de leur réexportation; la destination ultime de ces produits est inconnue lorsqu'ils quittent le Canada.) La classification des pays utilisée par la Division du commerce extérieur de Statistique Canada a été conçue aux fins de la géographie économique et ne reflète donc pas l'opinion du Gouvernement du Canada relativement aux questions de reconnaissance, de souveraineté ou de compétence en matière internationale.

6. **Révision des statistiques:** Les statistiques publiées pour le mois d'observation sont provisoires et susceptibles d'être révisées ou rectifiées en tout temps jusqu'à la parution du bulletin de janvier de l'année suivante. Les statistiques portant sur les années précédentes peuvent être rectifiées dans la publication d'avril. Les séries statistiques sont désaisonnalisées selon la *Census Method II* (version X-11); ces ajustements font également l'objet d'une révision chaque année dans la publication d'avril.

7. **Indexes of Price and Volume:** The price indexes in tables 3, 4, 5 and 6 are current-weighted and are calculated from price relatives based on 1971 = 100. The weights are trade quantities for the month, quarter or year to which the index refers and hence change from period to period. The volume index is derived by dividing a value index by the corresponding current-weighted price index. The resulting volume index is, therefore, weighted with fixed 1971 price weights. The price indicators selected are either commodity unit values calculated directly from the trade statistics or, particularly in the case of end products, price indexes obtained from other Canadian or foreign statistics.

An explanation of the methodology used to construct the indexes is contained in a reference paper entitled "The 1971-based Price and Volume Indexes of Canada's External Trade", published in December 1976 as a supplement to this publication (65-001).

Historical data from 1968 onwards is shown at the back of the June, July and August, 1977 publications. Most of the data series are also available on CANSIM.

8. **Provincial Detail:** Export statistics by province of lading indicate the province in which the goods were first laden aboard a carrier for export, which may not in all cases represent the province in which the goods were grown, extracted or manufactured. Import statistics by province of clearance indicate the province in which the goods were cleared by Customs either for immediate consumption or for entry into a bonded Customs warehouse; this may not always coincide with the province in which the goods are consumed or enter the productive process.

9. **Principal trading areas:** Effective January, 1976, the "principal trading areas" shown in some tables include new groupings which are defined below:

**Other E.E.C.:** Belgium, Denmark, France, Germany (F.R.), Ireland, Italy, Luxembourg, Netherlands (the U.K. is also a member of the E.E.C. but is shown separately because of the importance of its trade with Canada).

**Other O.E.C.D.:** Austria, Finland, Greece, Iceland, Norway, Portugal, Spain, Sweden, Switzerland, Turkey, Australia, New Zealand. (The E.E.C. countries, United States, Japan and Canada are also members of O.E.C.D. - The Organization for Economic Cooperation and Development).

**Other America:** This group includes all countries and territories of North and South America (other than the United States and Canada) including Greenland, Bermuda and Puerto Rico.

10. **Sources of Further Information:** More detailed monthly, quarterly and annual trade statistics are published in the 65-xxx series of Statistics Canada publications. Detailed descriptions and indexes of the commodity classifications are also available. See the Statistics Canada publications catalogue for descriptions of the contents of the various publications. As a result of continuous research on trade statistics, additional reference materials are published from time to time. For example, *The Reconciliation of U.S.-Canada Trade Statistics*, published by the United States - Canada Trade Statistics Committee, is available on request from the address given below.

Questions concerning details of methods not covered by these notes should be addressed in writing to the Director, External Trade Division, Statistics Canada, Ottawa, Ontario K1A 0V5.

7. **Indices de prix et de volume:** Les indices de prix compris dans les tableaux 3, 4, 5, et 6 sont pondérés d'après les quantités mensuelles, trimestrielles ou annuelles du commerce correspondantes à la période de l'indice et sont calculés d'après des prix relatifs de base 1971 = 100. Par conséquence ces pondérations sont variables d'une période à l'autre. Les indices du volume sont calculés en divisant l'indice de la valeur par l'indice du prix correspondant. L'indice du volume obtenu est donc implicitement pondéré par les prix fixes de l'année 1971. Les prix relatifs sont dérivés ou des valeurs unitaires calculés directement des statistiques du commerce extérieur ou sont dérivés surtout pour les produits finis, des indices de prix obtenus d'autres sources canadiennes ou de l'étranger.

Des renseignements concernant la méthodologie employée dans le calcul des indices sont données dans un document de référence intitulé "Les indices de prix et de volume de base 1971 du commerce extérieur du Canada" publié en décembre 1976 sous forme de supplément à la présente publication (65-001).

Des données rétrospectives depuis 1968 sont montrées dans les dernières pages des éditions de juin, juillet et août, 1977. La plupart des séries sont aussi disponibles sur CANSIM.

8. **Statistiques provinciales:** Les statistiques des exportations par province de chargement indiquent la province où les biens ont d'abord été confiés à un transporteur en vue de leur exportation; il ne s'agit donc pas toujours de la province où les biens ont été cultivés, extraits ou fabriqués. Les statistiques des importations par province de dédouanement présentent la province où les biens ont passé la douane en vue d'une consommation immédiate ou de leur entreposage en douane; cette province peut différer de la province de consommation ou d'entrée dans l'activité productive.

9. **Marchés principaux:** A partir de janvier 1976, les "marchés principaux" apparaissant dans certains tableaux comprennent les nouveaux groupements définis ci-dessous:

**Autres C.E.E.:** Allemagne (R.F.), Belgique, Danemark, France, Irlande, Italie, Luxembourg, Pays-Bas (le Royaume-Uni est aussi membre de la C.E.E. mais il est séparé dans les statistiques à cause de son importance dans le commerce du Canada).

**Autres O.C.D.E.:** Autriche, Espagne, Finlande, Grèce, Islande, Norvège, Portugal, Suède, Suisse, Turquie, Australie, Nouvelle-Zélande. (Les pays membres de la C.E.E., les États-Unis, le Japon et le Canada sont aussi membres de l'O.C.D.E. - l'Organisation pour la coopération et le développement économique.)

**Autres Amérique:** Cette catégorie comprend tous les pays et les territoires de l'Amérique du nord et du sud (sauf les États-Unis et le Canada), y compris le Groënland, les Bermudes et Porto Rico.

10. **Sources de renseignements supplémentaires:** Des statistiques mensuelles, trimestrielles et annuelles plus détaillées sur le commerce paraissent dans la série 65-xxx des publications de Statistique Canada. On peut également se procurer des descriptions détaillées et des index des classifications de marchandises. Veuillez consulter le catalogue des publications de Statistique Canada pour une description du contenu des diverses publications. La recherche continue dans le domaine de la statistique du commerce donne naissance de temps à autre à de nouveaux documents de référence. Ainsi, on peut obtenir à l'adresse mentionnée ci-dessous un document sur le rapprochement des statistiques du commerce États-Unis-Canada publié par le comité de la statistique du commerce États-Unis-Canada.

### C. Changes in Definitions and Procedures Which Affect External Trade Data for 1978

(a) Starting with May 1978 data, the statistical month includes all shipments for which Customs documents are received at Statistics Canada, up to, and including the last working day of the month (see Note 4). For the period January 1978 to April 1978, it included all shipments for which Customs documents were received up to the 29th of the reference month or the working day nearest the 29th.

(b) A number of classification changes at the Import Commodity Classification (MCC) and Export Commodity Classification (XCC) class level have been made as a result of the 1978 revision of the 1972 7-digit Canadian International Trade Classification (CITC). A complete description of the MCC and XCC changes, effective January 1, 1978, is given at the front of the January edition of Catalogue 65-007 monthly "Imports by commodities" and Catalogue 65-004 monthly "Exports by commodities".

(c) The changes in classification, just noted in (b), may have an impact on the definition of the commodity categories used in tables M-3 and X-3. The revised concordance between categories, and MCC/XCC classes is given at the front of the January-March 1978 issues of Catalogue 65-006 quarterly "Imports by countries" and Catalogue 65-003 quarterly "Exports by countries".

(d) The most significant classification changes are the transfer of bulk pharmaceutical products from Section 5 (End Products) 1977 classes 87134-87499 and 87930-87999 to Section 4 (Fabricated Materials) 1978 classes 41291 and 41301-41399. This change will create data discontinuities at all levels of the classification, although the effect at the level of Section totals is minor.

(e) Charts III to VII are new charts in which a trend line is shown. The trend lines are calculated as weighted (Henderson weights) 13-term moving averages of the seasonally adjusted series.

### C. Changements de définitions et de procédures ayant un effet sur les données pour le commerce extérieur en 1978

(a) À partir de mai, 1978, le mois statistique comprend toutes les livraisons pour lesquelles Statistique Canada a reçu des documents de douane jusqu'au dernier jour ouvrable du mois (voir note 4). Pendant la période de janvier 1978 à avril 1978, le mois statistique visait toutes les livraisons dont les documents de douane furent reçus jusqu'au 29 du mois de référence où jusqu'à la journée ouvrable la plus proche du 29.

(b) Certaines modifications ont été apportées à la classification des marchandises à l'importation (CMI) et à la classification des marchandises à l'exportation (CME). Ces modifications ont été nécessitées par la révision de 1978 de la classification canadienne du commerce internationale (CCCI, version 1972) au niveau de sept chiffres. Une description détaillée des changements à la CMI et à la CME en vigueur le premier janvier 1978 se trouve dans les premières pages de l'édition de janvier 1978 du catalogue 65-007 mensuel "Importations par marchandises" et du catalogue 65-004 mensuel "Exportations par marchandises".

(c) Les modifications à la classification mentionnées en (b), pourront avoir un effet sur la définition des catégories de marchandises employées dans les tableaux M-3 et X-3. Une version révisée des concordances entre les catégories de marchandises et les classes de la CMI et de la CME respectivement apparaît dans les premières pages de l'édition de janvier-mars 1978 du catalogue 65-006 trimestriel "Importations par pays" et du catalogue 65-003 trimestriel "Exportations par pays".

(d) La plus importante modification à la classification fut introduite par le déplacement des produits pharmaceutiques en vrac de la section 5 (Produits finis), classes 87134-87499 et 87930-87999 en 1977 à la section 4 (Matières-travaillées) classes 41291 et 41301-41399 en 1978. Ce changement entraînera des discontinuités dans les données à chaque niveau de la classification, mais l'effet sera peu significatif au niveau de la section.

(e) Les graphiques III à VII sont nouveaux et la tendance y est montrée. Les tendances sont calculées (pondération Henderson) avec des moyennes mobiles à treize termes basées sur des séries corrigées de variations saisonnières, les exportations de pétrole brut et de gaz naturel; et les importations selon l'arrangement avec les États-Unis pour des échanges de pétrole brut d'un mois donné sont présentés dans les
