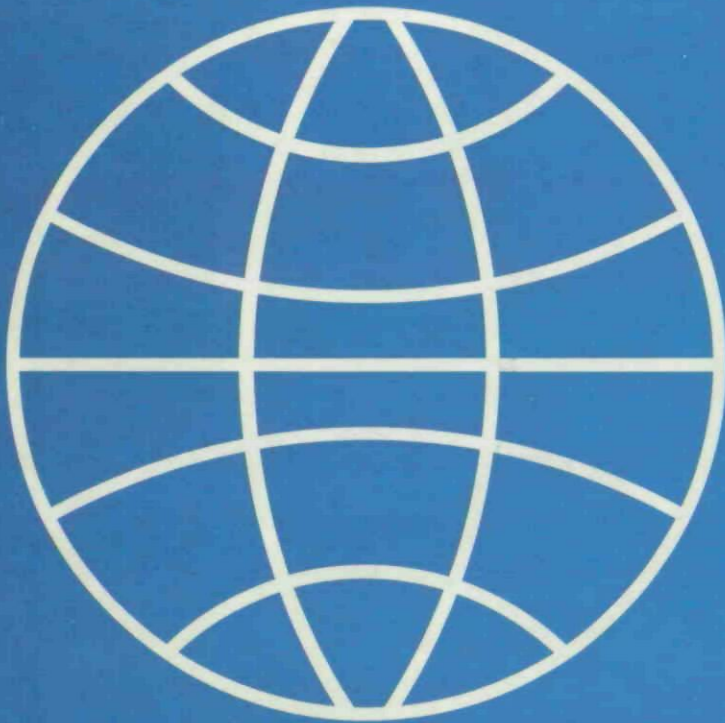

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REVIEW OF INTERNATIONAL TRAVEL

The number of United States visitors to Canada up to November 1971 has increased by 3.2 per cent over last year, down from the 4.2 per cent increase recorded between the period January - November 1970 and the previous year. Overseas travellers to Canada over 10 months of 1971 have not increased substantially, while the previous year visitors from overseas had increased 15.9 per cent from 1969.

Canadian residents continue to take trips overseas in increasing numbers, while travel to the United States has slowed, off 4.2 per cent from 1970.

TRAVEL BETWEEN CANADA AND THE UNITED STATES

Visitors to Canada from the United States for the eleven months ended November 30, 1971 increased by 3.2 per cent above the previous year. Residents of the United States who entered Canada by automobile increased by 3.6 per cent over 1970, as persons entering and leaving Canada the same day increased by over 400,000. Plane, rail and boat traffic all decreased, with rail traffic showing the greatest decline - off 53.5 per cent from January to November 1970.

For the month of November, the number of United States residents entering Canada increased by 3.5 per cent, as all forms of transportation recorded increases except rail and boat traffic. At the same time Canadian residents returning from the United States declined by 86,000 persons from November 1970, with the majority of the decline attributed to automobile traffic.

TRAVEL BETWEEN CANADA AND OVERSEAS COUNTRIES

Each month in 1971 has seen larger numbers of Canadian residents returning direct from overseas countries from the same period in 1970, except for the months of April and June. As a result the numbers of Canadian residents returning directly from visits overseas have increased by 8.1 per cent from January - November 1970.

Ottawa International Airport recorded substantial increases in Canadians returning direct from overseas each month throughout the year for a cumulative increase of 82.3 per cent. Toronto and Halifax International Airports showed significant increases of 24.4 and 18.8 per cent, respectively.

Overseas visitors to Canada for the period January - November 1971 numbered 512,600 persons, approximately the same number as last year. A disaggregation of the data indicates that the continents of Europe, North America, South America, and Oceania all recorded less visitors to our country in 1971. The continent of Asia recorded 63,157 visitors who came to Canada this year, as more persons came from Japan, Taiwan (Formosa) and Hong Kong.

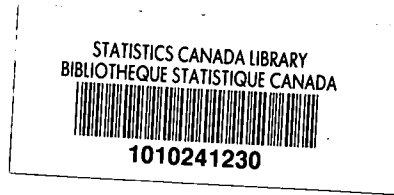
