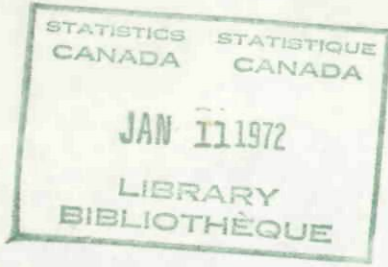
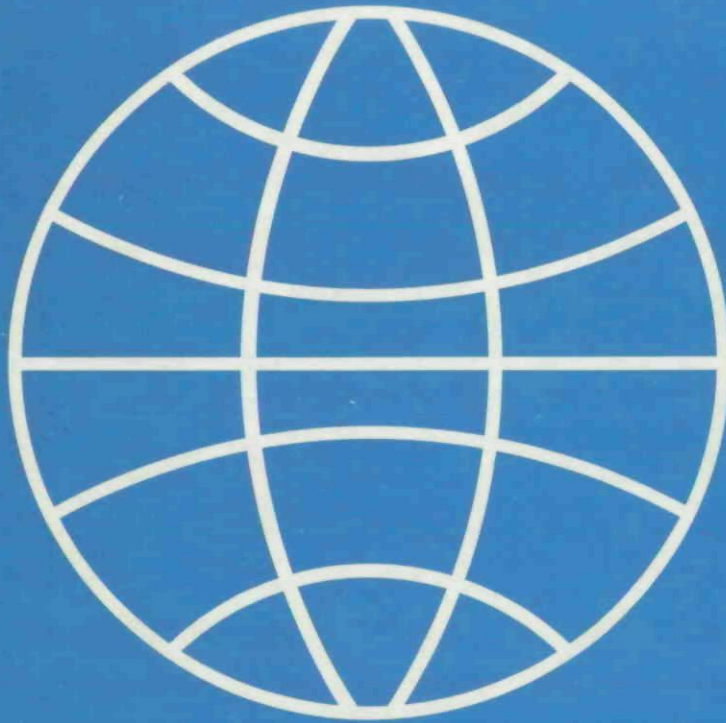

## REVIEW OF INTERNATIONAL TRAVEL

Preliminary estimates of Canada's Travel Account in the Balance of International Payments for the period January - September, 1971 showed a reduction in the deficit over the same period last year of \$53 million, leaving a deficit balance of \$142 million. Receipts from tourism spending by United States residents totalled \$978 million, accounting for 88.7 per cent of Canada's earnings from international travellers this year. Canadians continued to travel to overseas countries in increasing numbers, spending \$468 million overseas, an increase of \$20 million over the same period in 1970. Canadians spent \$776 million in the United States so far this year (\$792 million in 1970).

### TRAVEL BETWEEN CANADA AND THE UNITED STATES

United States residents who entered Canada in September 1971 by automobile increased by approximately 145,000 persons over the same period in 1970, while those using other means of transport decreased marginally in relation to September 1970. Only persons who entered Canada by bus showed any significant increase, up 15,600 persons over last year. Most provinces recorded increased numbers of United States resident visitors in September; however Prince Edward Island, Nova Scotia, Saskatchewan, and the Yukon Territory, all recorded minor declines in United States traffic.

The number of Canadian residents returning from visits to the United States in September declined by 145,000 from the same period in 1970, as Canadians using all forms of transportation recorded decreases, except bus transportation. The province of Ontario recorded a decrease of 94,000 returning residents, while British Columbia recorded 51,000 fewer returnees.

Travel between Canada and the United States for the nine month period of 1971 follows a similar pattern to the month of September. United States visitors to Canada were up by 805,000 (+ 2.6 %) over 1970 while Canadians returning from visits to the United States this year decreased by 1,251,000 (- 4.4 %) from 1970.

### TRAVEL BETWEEN CANADA AND OVERSEAS COUNTRIES

Residents of overseas countries visiting Canada in September declined by 2,262 persons from the same period last year. Most of the decline occurred in some of the major trading nations of the world - e.g. the United Kingdom, Australia and New Zealand.

So far this year, Canada attracted approximately the same number of overseas visitors as last year - that is, 448,000 persons. Visitors from the United Kingdom fell by 6.2 per cent from last year, while Japan, Taiwan, Hong Kong, Israel and West Germany all recorded large increases.

The number of Canadian residents returning directly from overseas countries in 1971 was 864,000, an increase of 4.9 per cent above 1970. Toronto International Airport recorded the largest increase in the numbers returning for the month of September, up 18,700 residents.
