ON TRAVELLERS' VEHICLE PERMITS

NOVEMBER, 1961 PROPERTY OF THE

Travellers' vehicle permits issued to foreign vehicles entering Canada during the month of November numbered 353,327 representing an increase of 17,000 or 5.1 per cent over November 1960. Cumulative data for the first eleven months of the year show 6,437,717 permits issued, an increase over the corresponding period of 1960 amounting to 352,423 entries or 5.8 per cent.
