VOLUME OF HIGHWAY TRAFFIC ENTERING CANADA
ON TRAVELLERS' VEHICLE PERMITS
SEPTEMBER, 1961

Travellers' vehicle permits issued to foreign vehicles entering Canada during the month of September numbered 714,326 which represents an increase of 46,927, or 7.0 per cent over September 1960. Cumulative data for the first nine months of 1961 show 5,623,246 permits issued, an increase over the corresponding period of 1960 amounting to 331,075 vehicles or 6.3 per cent.
