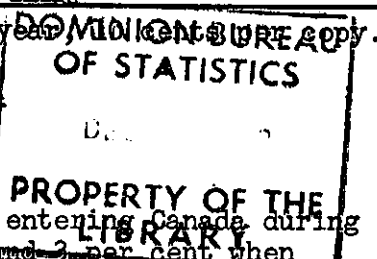

VOLUME OF HIGHWAY TRAFFIC ENTERING CANADA
ON TRAVELLERS' VEHICLE PERMITS
OCTOBER - 1962



Travellers' vehicle permits issued to foreign vehicles entering Canada during October numbered 449,712, a decrease of 11,432 or between 2 and 3 per cent when compared with October 1961. Cumulative data for the first ten months of 1962 show 6,444,538 permits issued, an increase over the corresponding period of 1961 amounting to 359,874 or nearly 6 per cent.
