VOLUME OF HIGHWAY TRAFFIC ENTERING CANADA ON TRAVELLERS' VEHICLE PERMITS NOVEMBER - 1962

Foreign vehicles entering Ganada on travellers' vehicle permits during the month of November numbered 371,991, an increase of 18,664 or 5.3 per cent when compared with the corresponding month of 1961. Cumulative entries for the first eleven months of 1962 amounted to 6,816,529, an increase of 378,838 or nearly 6 per cent when compared with the same period of 1961.
