Foreign vehicles entering Canada on travellers' vehicle permits during the month of December numbered 336,186, an increase of 11,970 or 3.7 percent over the same month of 1961. Cumulative figures for the calendar year show an all time record of 7,152,715 entries, the first time the 7 million mark has been reached. The increase over 1961 amounted to 390,508 entries or 5.8 per cent.
