VOLUME OF HIGHWAY TRAFFIC ENTERING CANADAON TRAVELLERS' VEHICLE PERMITSFEBRUARY, 1962

Foreign vehicles entering Canada on travellers' vehicle permits during the month of February 1962 totalled 241,292, a decrease of 4,698 or 1.9 per cent when compared with the corresponding month of 1961. Cumulative entries for the first two months amounted to 485,332, a decrease of 16,456 or 3.3 per cent when compared with the same period of the previous year.
