## VOLUME OF HIGHWAY TRAFFIC ENTERING CANADA ON TRAVELLERS' VEHICLE PERMITS MARCH, 1962

Travellers' vehicle permits issued to foreign vehicles entering Canada during the month of March 1962 numbered 329,171 representing an increase of 24,896 or 8.2 per cent over March 1961. Cumulative data for the first quarter of the year show 814,503 permits issued, an increase over the same period of 1961 amounting to 8,440 entries or 1.0 per cent.
