Travellers' vehicle permits issued to foreign vehicles entering Canada in May 1962 amounted to 560,761, marking an increase of 40,170 or 7.6 per cent over May 1961. Cumulative data for the first five months of 1962 show 1,809,814 permits issued, a gain of 76,434 or 4.4 per cent over the same period of 1961.


