Travellers' vehicle permits issued to foreign vehicles in July, 1962 amounted to 1,293,797, an increase of 17,598 or 1.4 per cent. Data for June and July show 2,132,632 permits issued, an increase of 141,680 or 7.1 per cent. Cumulative data for the first seven months show an increase of 218,114 or 5.9 per cent.
