ON TRAVELLERS' VEHICLE PERMITS AUGUST, 1962

Travellers' vehicle permits issued to foreign vehicles in August 1962 amounted to 1,337,167, an increase of 152,305 or 12.9 per cent over August 1961. Cumulative data for the first eight months of 1962 show 5,279,613 permits issued, a gain of 370,419 or 7.5 per cent compared with the same period of 1961.
