VOLUME OF HIGHWAY TRAFFIC ENTERING CANADA
ON TRAVELLERS' VEHICLE PERMITS
DECEMBER - 1963

Foreign vehicles entering Canada on travellers' vehicle permits numbered 336,222 in December, practically unchanged from the corresponding month of 1962. Cumulative entries for the calendar year show an all time record of 7,546,213 entries, an increase of 393,498 or 5.5 per cent above the previous record established in 1962.
