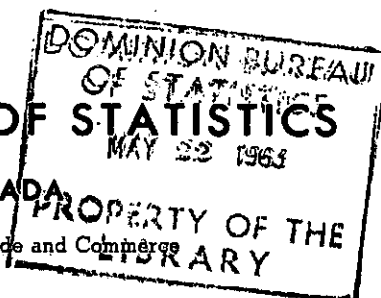

VOLUME OF HIGHWAY TRAFFIC ENTERING CANADA
ON TRAVELLERS' VEHICLE PERMITS
APRIL, 1963

Foreign vehicles entering Canada on travellers' vehicle permits numbered 466,326 in April 1963, an increase of 31,776 or 7.3 per cent over April 1962. Cumulative entries for the period of January-April amounted to 1,329,631, a gain of 80,578 or 6.5 per cent over the same period of 1962.
