VOLUME OF HIGHWAY TRAFFIC ENTERING CANADA
ON TRAVELLERS' VEHICLE PERMITS PROPERTY OF THE
JULY, 1963 LIBRARY

Travellers' vehicle permits issued to admit foreign vehicles into Canada in July 1963 numbered 1,365,162, an increase of 71,365 or 5.5 per cent over the corresponding month of 1962. Cumulative entries for the period of January-July amounted to 4,179,067 a gain of 236,621 or 6 per cent over the same period the previous year.
