VOLUME OF HIGHWAY TRAFFIC ENTERING CANADA
ON TRAVELLERS' VEHICLE PERMITS
JANUARY, 1964

Foreign vehicles entering Canada on travellers' vehicle permits during the month of January 1964, numbered 302,366 and established a new record for the month. The new record represents an increase of 51,330 entries over January 1963 and 46,568 or 18.2 per cent above the previous record for the month established in 1961.
