VOLUME OF HIGHWAY TRAFFIC ENTERING CANADA
ON TRAVELLERS' VEHICLE PERMITS
NOVEMBER - 1964

Foreign vehicles entering Canada on travellers' vehicle permits during November 1964 numbered 425,387. This represents an increase of 24,739 or 6.2 per cent when compared with the corresponding month of 1963. Cumulative entries for the first eleven months of 1964 amounted to 7,711,299, an advance of 501,278 or 7 per cent over the same period of 1963.
