VOLUME OF HIGHWAY TRAFFIC ENTERING CANADA  
ON TRAVELLERS' VEHICLE PERMITS  
DECEMBER - 1964

Travellers' vehicle permits issued for the admission of foreign vehicles into Canada in December 1964 totalled 355,206, an advance of 18,984 or 5.6 per cent above December 1963. Cumulative data for the 1964 calendar year show a record 8,066,505 permits issued, an increase over 1963 of 520,262 or 6.9 per cent.
