VOLUME OF HIGHWAY TRAFFIC ENTERING CANADA  
ON TRAVELLERS' VEHICLE PERMITS  
FEBRUARY - 1964

Travellers' vehicle permits issued to foreign vehicles entering Canada in February 1964 numbered 324,179, an increase of 62,656 or 24 per cent over the same period of 1963. Contributing to this increase was an extra day in the month which occurred over a week end. Entries for the first two months amounted to 626,545, an increase of 113,986 or 22 per cent over the corresponding period of 1963.
