VOLUME OF HIGHWAY TRAFFIC ENTERING CANADA
ON TRAVELLERS' VEHICLE PERMITS
MARCH - 1964

Foreign vehicles entering Canada on travellers' vehicle permits during the month of March numbered 370,382, an increase of 19,636 or 5.6 per cent over the corresponding month of 1963. Cumulative entries for the first quarter totalled 996,927 as compared with 863,305 in the same period of 1963, an increase of 133,622 or 15.5 per cent.
