## VOLUME OF HIGHWAY TRAFFIC ENTERING CANADA ON TRAVELLERS' VEHICLE PERMITS APRIL - 1964

Travellers' vehicle permits issued for the admission of foreign vehicles into Canada in April numbered 462,877, a decrease of 3,449 or 0.7 per cent in comparison with April 1963. This decrease can, no doubt, be attributed to the Easter traffic which this year was recorded in March. Cumulative entries for January-April 1964 amounted to 1,459,804, a gain of 130,173 or 9.8 per cent over the same period of 1963.
