VOLUME OF HIGHWAY TRAFFIC ENTERING CANADA ON TRAVELLERS! VEHICLE PERMITS SEPTEMBER - 1964

Travellers' vehicle permits issued in September numbered 804,393, an increase of 112,881 or 16.3 per cent over the same month of 1963. Entries in August and September together totalled 2,226,801 as compared with 2,108,084 in the corresponding period of 1963, an increase of 118,717 or 5.6 per cent. Cumulative data for the January-September period showed a gain of 445,299 entries or 7.1 per cent.
