ON TRAVELLERS' VEHICLE PERMITS
JANUARY, 1965

Foreign vehicles entering Canada on travellers' vehicle permits during the month of January 1965, numbered 294,996. This represents a decline of 7,379 entries or 2.4 per cent when compared with the record for the month which was established in 1964. All provinces show a decrease with the exception of the Atlantic Provinces and the Yukon Territory.
