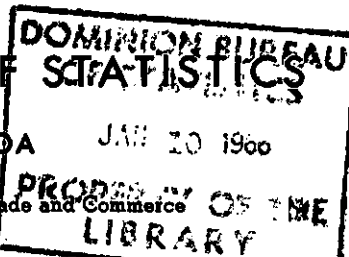

VOLUME OF HIGHWAY TRAFFIC ENTERING CANADA ON TRAVELLERS' VEHICLE PERMITS

NOVEMBER 1965

Travellers' vehicle permits issued to admit foreign vehicles into Canada in November numbered 457,233 as compared with 425,445 in November 1964, an increase of 31,788 or between 7 and 8 per cent. Cumulative data for the eleven month period of January - November inclusive show a total of 8,044,171 compared to 7,712,011 in the same period of 1964, a gain of 332,160 or 4.3 per cent.
