A ON TRAVELLERS VEHICLE REPORTS

Travellers' vehicle permits issued for the admission of foreign vehicles into Canada in April numbered 498,518, an increase of 35,577 or 7.7 per cent in comparison with April 1964. No doubt, the shift of Easter from March in 1964 to April in 1965 may have influenced the trend. A comparison of the two month period (March and April) shows a gain of 7,527 entries or 9 per cent over the same period of 1964.
