Travellers' vehicle permits issued to foreign vehicles entering Canada in June 1965 numbered 919,503, an increase of 13,138 or 1.4 per cent above the corresponding month in 1964. Entries for the first half of the year amounted to 3,075,181, an increase of 27,619 or almost 1 per cent.
