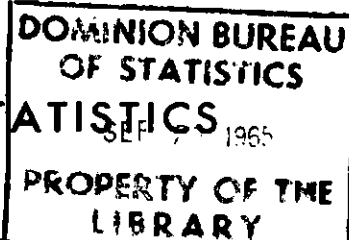

VOLUME OF HIGHWAY TRAFFIC ENTERING CANADA ON TRAVELLERS' VEHICLE PERMITS

AUGUST 1965

Travellers' vehicle permits issued to foreign vehicles entering Canada during August 1965 numbered 1,504,483, an increase of 82,022 or 5.8 per cent over the corresponding month in 1964. The cumulative figure for January - August 1965, some 6,151,416, marks an increase of 222,851 or 3.8 per cent over the same period last year.
