VOLUME OF HIGHWAY TRAFFIC ENTERING CANADA ON TRAVELLERS' VEHICLE PERMITS

OCTOBER 1966

Travellers' vehicle permits issued to foreign vehicles entering Canada during October numbered 626,070 which represents an increase of 39,488 or 6.7 per cent over October 1965. Cumulative data for the January - October period show 8,104,556 permits issued, an increase over the same period of 1965 amounting to 517,618 entries or 6.8 per cent.

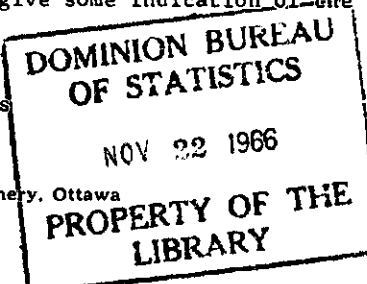
