VOLUME OF HIGHWAY TRAFFIC ENTERING CANADA ON TRAVELLERS' VEHICLE PERMITS

NOVEMBER 1966

Travellers' vehicle permits issued to admit foreign vehicles into Canada in November 1966 numbered 479,006, an increase of 21,775 or 4.8 per cent above the corresponding month of 1965. Cumulative data for the first eleven months show a total of 8,583,572, a gain of 539,403 or 6.7 per cent higher than the same period of the previous year.

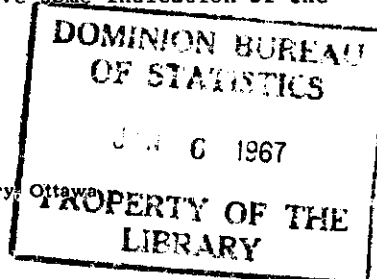
(1) Includes permits issued to all foreign vehicles regardless of length of stay in Canada. Entries via Newfoundland and Nova Scotia are by vessel.
