## VOLUME OF HIGHWAY TRAFFIC ENTERING CANADA ON TRAVELLERS' VEHICLE PERMITS

DECEMBER 1966

Foreign vehicles entering Canada on travellers' vehicle permits during December numbered 431,423, an increase of 13,194 or 3.2 per cent over the corresponding month of 1965. Cumulative data show that 9,014,995 permits were issued during the year, an increase of 552,597 or 6.5 per cent over the previous record of 8,462,398 which was established in 1965.
