VOLUME OF HIGHWAY TRAFFIC ENTERING CANADA ON TRAVELLERS' VEHICLE PERMITS

APRIL 1966

Travellers' vehicle permits issued to admit foreign vehicles into Canada in April 1966 numbered 559,930 as compared with 498,512 in April 1965, an increase of 61,418 or 12.3 per cent. Cumulative data for January - April inclusive, show 1,678,271 entries compared to 1,429,835 in 1965, a gain of 248,436 or 17.4 per cent for the four month period.
