VOLUME OF HIGHWAY TRAFFIC ENTERING CANADA ON TRAVELLERS' VEHICLE PERMITS

MAY 1966

Travellers' vehicle permits issued to admit foreign vehicles into Canada in May 1966 numbered 717,137, a decrease of 8,706 or 1.2 per cent below the same month of 1965. Cumulative entries for the period of January-May inclusive, totalled 2,395,408, an increase of 239,730 or 11.1 per cent over the corresponding period of 1965.
