## VOLUME OF HIGHWAY TRAFFIC ENTERING CANADA ON TRAVELLERS' VEHICLE PERMITS

## **MAY 1966**

Travellers' vehicle permits issued to admit foreign vehicles into Canada in May 1966 numbered 717,137, a decrease of 8,706 or 1.2 per cent below the same month of 1965. Cumulative entries for the period of January—May inclusive, totalled 2,395,408, an increase of 239,730 or 11.1 per cent over the corresponding period of 1965.
