## VOLUME OF HIGHWAY TRAFFIC ENTERING CANADA ON TRAVELLERS' VEHICLE PERMITS

### JUNE 1966

Foreign vehicles entering Canada on travellers' vehicle permits during the month of June 1966 numbered 1,000,409, an increase of 80,906 or 8.8 per cent more than in June 1965. Cumulative data show 3,395,817 permits were issued during the first half of 1966, a gain of 320,636 or 10.4 per cent over the aggregate for the same period of 1965.
