VOLUME OF HIGHWAY TRAFFIC ENTERING CANADA ON TRAVELLERS' VEHICLE PERMITS

AUGUST 1966

Travellers' vehicle permits issued to admit foreign vehicles into Canada in August 1966 numbered 1,536,600, an increase of 32,117 or 2.1 per cent above the same month of 1965. Cumulative entries for the first eight months totalled 6,591,822, a gain of 440,406 or 7.2 per cent higher than the same period of 1965.
