VOLUME OF HIGHWAY TRAFFIC ENTERING CANADA ON TRAVELLERS' VEHICLE PERMITS

SEPTEMBER 1966

Foreign vehicles entering Canada on travellers' vehicle permits during the month of September totalled 885,239, an increase of 36,299 or 4.3 per cent over the same month of 1965. Cumulative data show that 7,477,162 permits were issued during the first three quarters of 1966, a gain of 476,806 entries or 6.8 per cent over the aggregate for the same period of 1965.
