## VOLUME OF HIGHWAY TRAFFIC ENTERIXG CANADA ON TRAVELLER'S VEHICLE PERMITS

Foreign vehicles entering "Canada on traveller's vehicle permits in October totalled 128,100, an increase of 1.5 per cent over the same month last year. Decreases were recorded in Ontario and British Columbia and increases in all other provinces. The number of vehicles by province of entry was as follows, with corresponding figures for October 1947 in brackets: Ontario 72,100 (73,500), Quebec $29,100(27,600)$, British Columbia 13,057 (13,122), Maritimes 9,600 ( 8,400 ), Manitoba 2,000 (1,900), Alberta, 1,100 (700), Saskatchewan 1,000 (800).

During the first ten months of this year the number of vehicles entering Canada on permits was $1,701,600$, an increase of 9.2 per cent over the same period in 1947.
