VOLUME OF HIGHWAY TRAFFIC ENTERING CANADA-ON TRAVELLER'S VEHICLE PERMITS

The number of foreign vehicles entering Canada on traveller's vehicle permits in the year 1948 was 1,824,000, a new record for this type of traffic and 10 per cent higher than the previous high mark established in 1947. All provinces shared in the increase over the previous year except British Columbia which suffered from the effects of floods in May and June.

Foreign entries on permits in December totalled 47,500, an increase of 26 per cent over the same month in 1947, whereas similar traffic in December, 1947, showed a decrease of 5 per cent from the year before.
