VOLUME OF HIGHWAY TRAFFIC ENTERING CANADA ON TRAVELLER'S VEHICLE PERMITS NOVEMBER. 1949

Foreign vehicles entering Canada on traveller's vehicle permits in November totalled 76,700, an increase of 2 per cent over the same month last year. Early snow resulted in lighter traffic in Quebec and Ontario but volume was maintained in the Maritimes and was considerably heavier than in the previous year in the Western provinces. Eleven month totals were up 9 per cent. The comparable advance in 1948 over 1947 was also 9 per cent.
