ON TRAVELLER'S VEHICLE PERMITSPECTED THE

Foreign vehicles entering Canada on traveller's vehicle permits in July totalled 453,400, an increase of 11 per cent over the same month last year. Practically all provinces shared in the increase over the corresponding month of 1948, with the greatest proportionate gain being in the Western Provinces and the Maritimes where traffic showed a gain of 25 per cent and 20 per cent respectively.

The number of entries during the first seven months was 13 per cent heavier than in 1948 the result of an increase each month.
