VOLTME OF HIGHWAY TRAFFIC ENTERING CANADA ON TRAVELIER'S VEHICLE PERMITS

Foreign vehicles entering Canada on traveller's vehicle permits in August totalled 426,700, an increase of 5 per cent over the same month last year. There were increases in the number of entries into nearly all provinces, the Maritime and Prairie provinces continuing to show higher percentage gains than the Central provinces and British Columbia

The number of entries for the first eight months was 10 per cent heavier than in 1948 with the greatest proportionate gain being in the Prairio provinces.
