VOLUME OF HIGHWAY TRAFFIC ENTERING CANADARY
ON TRAVELLER'S VEHICLE PERMITS
NOVEMBER, 1950

Foreign vehicles entering Canada on traveller's vehicle permits in November totalled 80,900, an advance of 6 per cent over the same month last year. Heavier traffic was reported by all provinces except Nova Scotia, Manitoba and British Columbia. Totals for 11 months were 3.5 per cent higher than last year with increases in all provinces except Nova Scotia and Manitoba.

Figures shown above refer almost exclusively to automobiles. They include a small number of taxis, motorcycles and bicycles, but exclude buses, trucks and other commercial vehicles.
