## VOLUME OF HIGHWAY TRAFFIC WNTERING CANAGRARY <br> ON TRAVBLIMR'S VEHICLI PWRMITIS: <br> NOVEMBTR, 1950

Foreign vehicles entering Canada on traveller's vehicle permits in November totalled 80,900, an advance of 6 per cent over the same month last year. Heavier traffic was reported by all provinces except Nova Scotia, Manitoba and British Columbia. Totals for 11 months ware 3.5 per cent higher than last year with increases in all provinces except Nova Scotia and Manitoba.
